Convocation of the 199th session of the Governing Council of the IPU

Geneva, 24 and 27 October 2016

Madam President, Mr. President,

The Governing Council of the Inter-Parliamentary Union will hold its 199th session at the *Centre international de Conférences de Genève (CICG)*, in Geneva.

1. PARTICIPATION

The Governing Council is composed of three members from each parliament represented in the IPU. Each parliament's representation on the Governing Council must include both men and women. Single-gender delegations will be limited to two members (Rule 1.2 of the Rules of the Governing Council).

2. PROCEEDINGS OF THE SESSION

The first sitting of the Governing Council will take place on Monday, 24 October, from 9 to 10.45 a.m., and will start by examining items 1 to 6. Time permitting, the Governing Council will also cover item 10: *Reports on recent IPU specialized meetings*.

At its second and third sittings, to be held on Thursday, 27 October, from 9.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 2.30 p.m. to approximately 5 p.m., the Governing Council will examine all other agenda items.

4. SUPPLEMENTARY ITEMS

In conformity with Governing Council Rule 13, members of the Council may request the inclusion of supplementary items in the agenda. Such items must fall within the mandate of the Council which, according to Article 20 of the Statutes, determines and guides the activities of the IPU and controls their implementation.

Any requests for the inclusion of supplementary items will be immediately transmitted by the Secretariat to all Council members. After hearing the opinion of the Executive Committee, the Council shall decide on such a request: (a) by a majority of votes cast if the request is received by the IPU Secretariat at least 15 days before the opening of the session; or (b) by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast if the request is received less than 15 days before the opening of the session.

5. DOCUMENTS

To the extent possible, working documents regarding various items of the provisional agenda will be sent out to Members and posted on the IPU website in advance.
