EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

On 6 October 2010, the Governing Council will be required to elect **two members** to fill the following seats on the Executive Committee.

African Group : One vacancy [expiry of the term of office of Ms. J. Fotso

(Cameroon)].

Twelve-Plus Group : One vacancy [expiry of the term of office of Mr. G. Versnick

(Belgium)].

IMPORTANT: The geopolitical Groups concerned are reminded that article 23.2 of the Statutes "At least three of the members elected must be women". In order to respect the Statutes of the IPU, at the moment of the election, at least one of the candidates elected to the Executive committee should be a women MP.

Candidatures from the corresponding regions, accompanied by a signed covering letter and a brief curriculum vitae (one page maximum), may be submitted up to Tuesday, 5 October, by 2.30 p.m.

Committee on the Human Rights of Parliamentarians

On 6 October 2010, the Governing Council will be required to elect **one substitute member** for the Latin-American Group, a vacancy not filled at the 186th session of the Governing Council.

Candidatures from the corresponding region, accompanied by a signed covering letter and a brief curriculum vitae (one page maximum), may be submitted up to Tuesday, 5 October, by 9 a.m.

Group of Facilitators for Cyprus

On 6 October 2010, the Governing Council will be required to elect **one facilitator**, a vacancy not filled at the 186th session of the Governing Council.

Candidatures, accompanied by a signed covering letter and a brief curriculum vitae (one page maximum), may be submitted up to Tuesday, 5 October, by 9 a.m.
