Statement

Mr. President,

Distinguished Delegates,

on behalf of the Sovereign Order of Malta and myself, I would like to thank the Governing Council and all the members of the IPU for the admission of the Order of Malta to the Inter-Parliamentary Union as an Observer.

It is an honour and a privilege for the Order to be admitted to the IPU, the prominent global organization of national Parliaments, which are the temple of democracy, rule of law, dialogue, cooperation and protection of fundamental rights and human dignity.

Principles and values which the Order of Malta shares, as witnessed by its millenary humanitarian mission in favour of the weak, the sick, the marginalised and the needy.

The Inter-Parliamentary Union and the Sovereign Order of Malta, through our Permanent Mission in Geneva, have established a good and mutually beneficial working relationship, with many areas of common interest, especially interfaith dialogue, peacebuilding, human rights and rule of law.

With these sentiments and promising perspectives, I look forward to an intense and fruitful cooperation between the Inter-Parliamentary Union and the Sovereign Order of Malta and I wish the 143rd Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union every success for the benefit of inclusive societies and mutual understanding among peoples.
