3. **Food self-sufficiency** — strengthening the Mexican countryside to ensure that no family goes hungry and restoring the dignity of our farmers, the historic guardians of the land.

This development model not only responds to national challenges; it is also aligned with the **Sustainable Development Goals of the 2030 Agenda**, showing that Mexico acts with global vision and local commitment.

On the international stage, Mexico has reaffirmed its role as an independent voice, committed to **multilateralism, peace, and cooperation**.

President Sheinbaum has made it clear: **Mexico neither submits nor isolates itself** — it **leads, engages in dialogue, and builds bridges**.

We have strengthened our relationships with strategic partners in North America, Latin America, Europe, Asia, and Africa, advancing alliances for development, climate justice, and human rights.

Mexico actively participates in multilateral forums, proposing joint solutions to the world's greatest challenges: **climate change, migration, inequality, energy transition, and global peace**.

I invite you all, from this honorable platform, to **strengthen our ties, to share experiences, and to build together a future** where democracy is not just a political system, but a **way of life more just, more equitable, and more humane**.

Let us continue legislating for a better world.
Let us continue transforming with hope.
