## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Assembly – Seating information

The setup of the Plenary Hall cannot be modified and, as such, seating is limited, with no second row of chairs.

Each delegation has been allocated sufficient seats for its Governing Council members (maximum three). For those delegations from countries with a population of more than 100 million inhabitants, an additional seat has been allocated where possible, and delegations led by Speakers also have an additional seat.

Additional seating is available in the Sala Multiusos 1 (spill-over room, with a capacity of 250 seats), on the ground floor of the main building next to the Internet café, which will have a live feed from the Plenary Chamber. Delegation members and staff who do not have seats in the Plenary Chamber are invited to make use of this spill-over room.
