While artificial intelligence (AI) presents potential benefits to humanity and development, recent major advances in AI and its rapid application across political, economic and social spheres also present immediate risks to democracy, human rights and the rule of law that must be urgently addressed by legislators around the world.

The preparatory debate will provide an opportunity for all Member Parliaments to express their opinion on the issues to be included in the resolution. The contributions will assist the co-Rapporteurs in drafting the resolution, which will be examined and finalized at the 149th IPU Assembly in October 2024.

4. **Workshop for parliamentarians on artificial intelligence**
Using a practical, hands-on approach, the workshop is designed to help parliamentarians build their knowledge of key aspects of AI.
5. **Debate on *Sustainable actions to improve the life conditions of people with disabilities, including their chances for education and work opportunities***

In all countries, people with disabilities continue to face barriers with regard to access to education and work. The debate will discuss these challenges and share good practices that can improve the life conditions of people with disabilities.

6. **Elections to the Bureau of the Standing Committee**
The Committee will fill the current vacancies on the Bureau based on proposals received from the geopolitical groups.
