The site is in the village of Garni, in Armenia Kotayk Province, around 30 km east of Yerevan. The generally accepted view, especially in Armenian historiography, postulates that it was built in 77 AD, during the reign of king Tiridates I of Armenia. The Garni Temple is the only pagan and Greco-Roman structure that has been preserved in the territory of Armenia. It is believed that Garni remained standing because it was widely recognized as a "masterpiece of art".
