Information note on registration and badges

In the interest of improving our security and the accuracy of attendance statistics at our Assemblies, we have implemented two extra steps in the registration system. One is the submission of a photo, which will be printed on Assembly badges, and the other is a request for a copy of delegates' passports.

We hope that these steps will reduce errors in data entry and ultimately lead to a more accurate List of Participants. The associated verification should also reduce the waiting time at the registration desk.

Badge collection

Badge collection will begin on **17 October at 09:00 at the IPU Headquarters Reception**. Please bring a paper or electronic copy of your confirmed delegation list, along with the email confirmation messages received from the IPU.

For those unable to collect badges at IPU Headquarters, badge collection will continue on **18 October at the CIGG Registration Desk**, starting at 14:00.

Queues will be organized by **alphabetical groups (e.g. A–D)** according to the name of the country or Associate Member organization. Delegates are kindly requested to join the queue corresponding to their alphabetical group.

Badge colours

Each badge is colour-coded according to registration type:

IPU Members Associate Members	Member of Parliament	Dark Blue
IPU Members Associate Members	Secretary General / Clerk Advisor or Secretary	Green
IPU Members Associate Members	Secretary General / Clerk ASGP member	Red
Permanent Observers	Delegate	Grey
Special Guests	Delegate	Orange
IPU Members Associate Members	Security	Brown
IPU Members Associate Members	Accompanying person	Pink
Media	N/A	Yellow
IPU Secretariat	N/A	Light Blue

Checking in and entry to the CIGG

Each badge has a unique QR code. Badge scanners will be available at the CIGG entrance after Registration. All participants must scan their badge's QR code and allow security staff to verify registration before they can enter the Assembly premises. This process will only take a few seconds.

Lost badges

Lost badges must be reported immediately to the IPU Registration Team, either by email (registration@ipu.org) or at the CIGG Registration Desk. Replacement badges will be issued on a case-by-case basis, subject to security considerations.
