We are pleased to invite you and members of your Parliament to the Parliamentary Meeting to be held at the 30th session of the Conference of the Parties of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (COP30), taking place on 14 November 2025 in Belém, Brazil. The meeting is being jointly organized by the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) and the Parliament of Brazil.

The annual COP conference is the world's most prominent gathering on climate change. As climate change impacts continue to intensify, international cooperation to advance climate action is more critical than ever. Parliaments have an instrumental role to play in accelerating implementation of the Paris Agreement and ensuring that the international promises made translate into concrete national action.

The Parliamentary Meeting is the foremost event for national parliaments during the COP. It provides a dedicated platform for the global parliamentary community to share knowledge on climate solutions, as well as an opportunity for parliamentarians to join forces to identify shared parliamentary solutions to pressing climate issues. As 2025 marks the deadline for revised Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), the Parliamentary Meeting will serve as an avenue for parliaments to advocate for the implementation of ambitious and inclusive NDCs that effectively reduce emissions and leave no one behind.

Your presence as Speaker of Parliament will be invaluable to the Meeting's success. Parliaments are also encouraged to nominate parliamentarians who work directly on climate and environment-related topics, including relevant Committee Chairs, to attend the meeting. Parliaments are invited to ensure that there is a gender balance in their delegations and that young parliamentarians are included. Interpretation will be provided in English, French, Spanish and Arabic.

In keeping with the usual practice of Parliamentary Meetings at the COP, an outcome document is expected to be adopted at the end of the meeting to identify the path forward for parliamentary action on climate change. The preliminary draft outcome document has been shared with IPU Member Parliaments. The draft text will also be presented at the 151st IPU Assembly, taking place from 19 to 23 October 2025 in Geneva. Proposals for amendments to the draft outcome document can be submitted to the IPU Secretariat (postbox@ipu.org) until 26 October 2025.

Please note that the IPU and the Parliament of Brazil are not in a position to facilitate accreditation to COP30 and will not be able to support logistical arrangements such as obtaining entry visas, accommodation and transportation.
