- About any other topic that is relevant to the conference

### Guidelines for videos for the Parliamentary showcase

- Length: Videos must be no more than 5 minutes long.
- Language: Videos can be in any language. If the video is not in English, please include subtitles in English.
- Limits: Parliaments can submit up to two videos to the Parliamentary showcase. It is fine to reuse videos that you have already created.
- Uploading: Videos can be sent via file transfer services (such as [wetransfer.com](https://www.wetransfer.com) to [assist-docs@ipu.org](mailto:assist-docs@ipu.org)) or uploaded to this shared folder on Google Drive for [Contributions from parliaments](#). Please include the name of your country in the file name.
- Deadline: Please let us know as soon as possible if you intend to make a video for the Parliamentary showcase. The final deadline for submitting a video is 21 November 2025.
- Publication: By submitting a video, parliament agrees for it to be published in the Parliamentary showcase and on the websites of the conference organizers.

The final decision on whether to include a video in the Parliamentary showcase lies with the conference organizers.
