Dear Presidents of the Delegations of the Twelve Plus Group,

Dear Members of the Twelve Plus Group,

It is our honour and pleasure to extend an invitation to your Group to attend a seminar co-organized by the Twelve Plus Geopolitical Group of the Inter-Parliamentary Union and the Sejm and Senate of Poland, entitled *“Human Rights in the Digital Era. AI and Social Media: “Opportunity or Threat for Youth?”*, to be held on 8–10 June 2026 in Warsaw, Poland. The seminar will commence on 8 June at 10 am (Warsaw local time).

The first day, 8 June will focus on protecting children online, including social media use, cyberspace safety, and relevant constitutional safeguards, reflecting initiatives in Australia, France, and other countries.

The second day, 9 June will examine AI and human rights, covering algorithmic accountability, surveillance, electoral interference, and implications for parliamentary oversight.

The third day, 10 June will include a full-day cultural visit to the State Museum at Majdanek concentration camp.

The seminar will be discussion-based and designed to encourage questions and exchange of experiences. Each panel will be structured as follows: panelists will present their views on the topic (approximately 5 minutes per speaker), followed by a discussion/debate moderated with active participation from attendees.

You are invited to send **a delegation of up to three members**, comprising parliamentarians and/or parliamentary staff. It is recommended that delegates be persons who work directly on AI and Human Rights issues.

The working languages of the seminar will be English, French and Polish. We ask that, as customary, participants make their own arrangements for travel and accommodation. The Parliament of Poland has negotiated a special rate at the Sheraton Grand Warsaw hotel (Bolesława Prusa 2, Warsaw).
