  - (b) Preparatory debate on the next resolution
    - The preparatory debate provides an opportunity for all Members to express their opinion on the issues to be included in the resolution. In addition, Members can submit written input to the resolution up to 20 April 2018.
    - Members' contributions will assist the Rapporteurs in drafting the resolution, which will be examined at the 139<sup>th</sup> IPU Assembly in October 2018.
- 4. Consideration of proposal for a debate on The role of parliaments in ending discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity, and ensuring respect for the human rights of LGBTI persons

In accordance with the decisions taken at the 137<sup>th</sup> IPU Assembly, the Committee is invited to give further consideration to this matter.
