## Provisional agenda of the Standing Committee on Democracy and Human Rights

The 139<sup>th</sup> IPU Assembly appointed Dr. H. Millat (Bangladesh) and Mr. C. Lohr (Switzerland) as co-Rapporteurs, and requested the IPU President to continue consultations with a view to appointing a woman parliamentarian from Africa as third co-Rapporteur at the 140<sup>th</sup> IPU Assembly.

(b) Preparatory debate on the next resolution

The preparatory debate provides an opportunity for all Members to express their opinion on the issues to be included in the resolution. The contributions from Members will assist the Rapporteurs in drafting the resolution, which will be examined and finalized at the 141<sup>st</sup> IPU Assembly in October 2019.

## 4. Debate on follow-up to previous IPU resolutions

The Committee will hold a panel debate to examine how IPU Members have followed up on three resolutions adopted by the IPU in recent years:

- 2015 Democracy in the digital era and the threat to privacy and individual freedoms
- 2013 The use of media, including social media, to enhance citizen engagement and democracy
- 2009 Freedom of expression and the right to information.

## 5. Elections to the Bureau of the Standing Committee

The Committee will fill the vacancies on the Bureau based on proposals received from the geopolitical groups.
