 - Consists of 40 Members of Parliament
 - Conducts Weekly meetings every Sunday
 - Has 8 Permanent Committees and 2 Ad-Hoc Committees.

The problem

High Paper Costs

- Printing Agenda and Minutes of meetings
- High Running Operation Costs
- Well over 70,000 pages printed every week.
- Printers Maintenance Costs

Delivering Documents

- Dedicated driver for every 10 MPs
- Delays in delivering documents
- Inconvenience
- Inaccessibility when MPs are traveling.

Departments

- Race with time to prepare all documents
- New Skills to be learned
- Multiple Departments Contribute.

Challenges Faced

Challenge 1

MPs Resistance

MPs are used to paper and were against going all digital.

Challenge 2

Cost

Cost of development would be high if this project was done through an outsourced vendor.

Challenge 3

Management

Change the business process to ensure success of the project, and to allocate resources differently within the Council's premises.

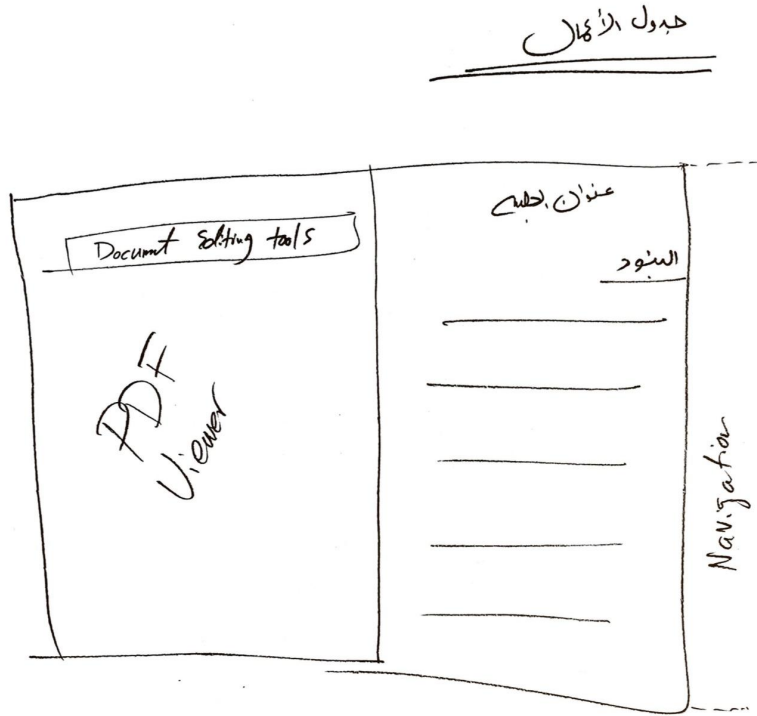


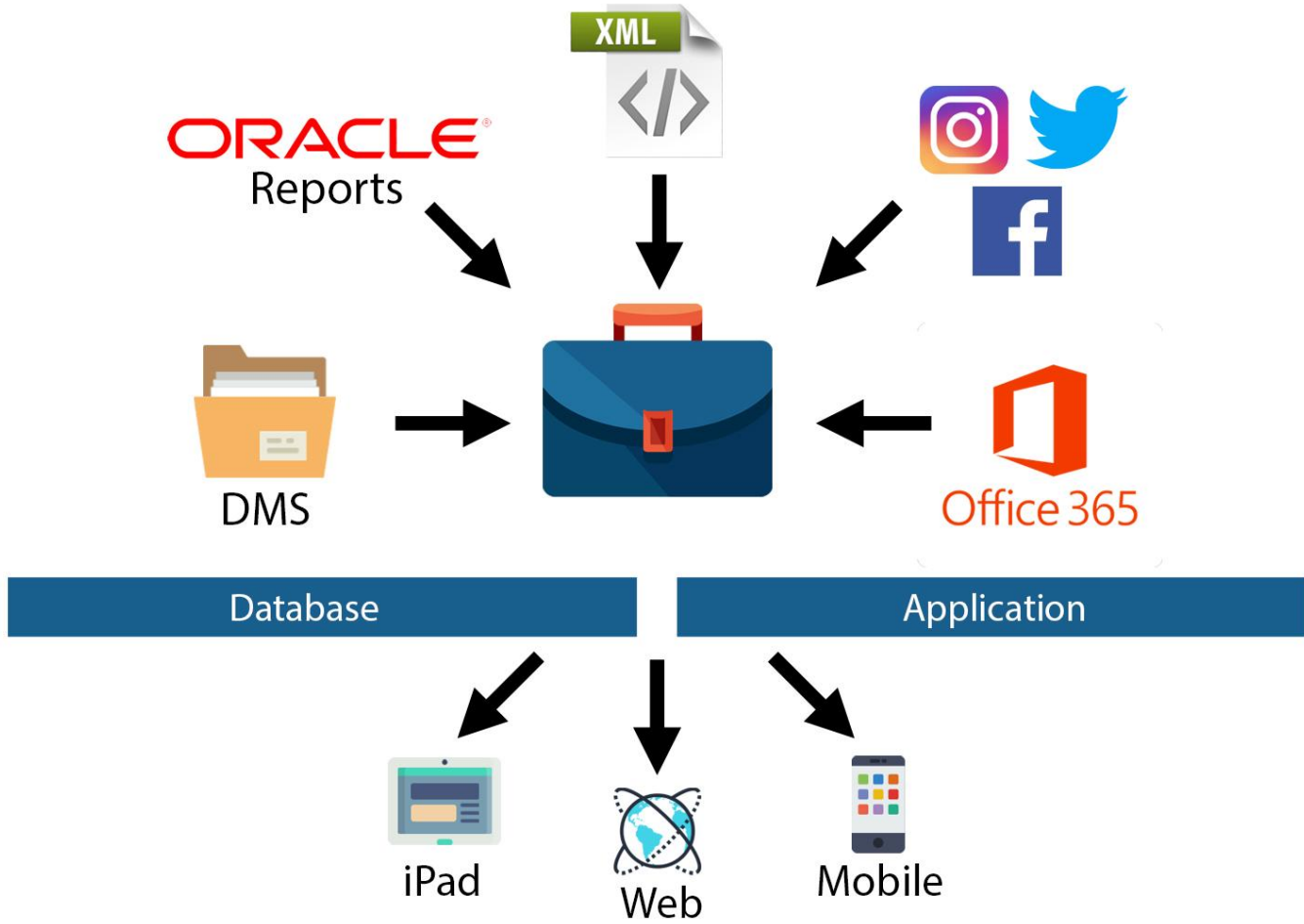

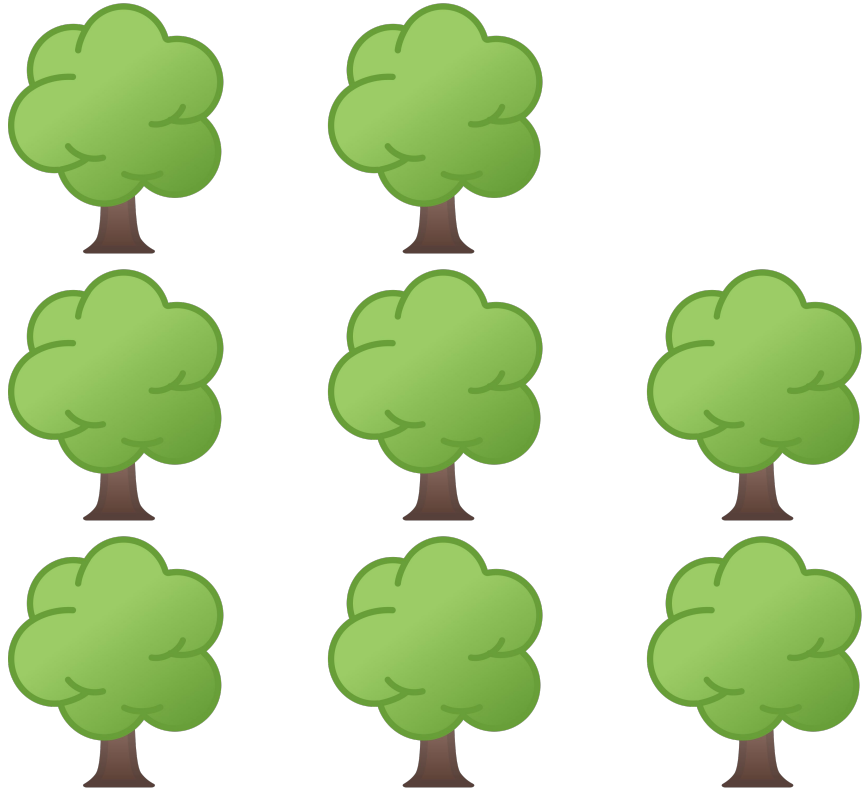
