- In the 2018 update, the number of research questions increased to 74 questions for 180 countries.
- Over 60 researchers from different institutions around the world were provided with coding instructions and asked to answer each of the 74 questions.

POLITICAL FINANCE REGULATORY COMPONENTS

Public funding

E.g. provisions for public funding, eligibility criteria, free/subsidised access to media, and gender-targeted public funding, etc

Private funding

E.g. regulations of foreign donations, corporate donations, anonymous donations, and donations from corporations with partial government ownership, etc

Regulations on spending

> E.g. ban on vote buying, spending caps, third party spending limits, and media spending limits, etc

Reporting, oversight and sanctions

E.g. types and mandates of electoral management bodies, etc








BANS ON FOREIGN DONATIONS




BANS ON CORPORATE DONATIONS



BANS ON ANONYMOUS DONATIONS




BANS ON DONATIONS FROM CORPORATIONS WITH PARTIAL GOVERNMENT OWNERSHIP




SPENDING LIMITS: POLITICAL PARTIES



SPENDING LIMITS: CANDIDATES




SPENDING LIMITS: THIRD PARTIES




