INFORMATION NOTE

Accreditation

The Parliamentary Forum and other IPU events at the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development are open exclusively to parliamentarians who are members of national delegations or who are otherwise able to receive accreditation from their respective Permanent Missions to the United Nations in New York.

Missions must accredit attendees. The IPU is not in a position to provide the required UN entry badge.

For the Senior Level Meeting of the Global Partnership for Effective Development Coopeartion (GPEDC), technically not an official event of the HLPF, parliamentarians need not be part of government delegations and can be accredited directly through the IPU. As IPU delegates they will receive a Special Event Ticket (see Entrance Badges below).

Registration

As members of national delegations, participating parliamentarians should receive support for travel and accommodation directly through their parliaments.

Entrance Badges

Security arrangements at the United Nations are very strict.

For the Parliamentary Forum, inside the UN compound, only those with the required badge provided by his/her country's Permanent Mission will be admitted.

IPU events held outside the UN compound do not require any entrance badge.

For the **Senior Level Meeting** of the GPEDC, participants can collect their Special Event Ticket directly from the IPU Office at the UN on the afternoon of Friday, 12 July (2 p.m. to 6 p.m.) or on Saturday, 13 July beginning at 8.30 a.m. The IPU Office is located inside Uganda House at 336 East 45th Street, 10th Floor (corner of 45th Street and 1st Avenue).
