3. **Contribution to the work of the 141st Assembly**

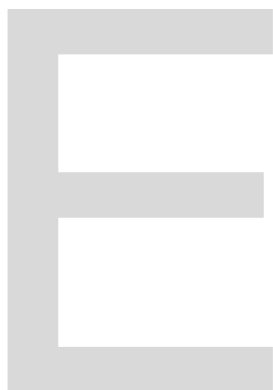
Members of the Forum will exchange views from a youth perspective on the theme of the General Debate of the 141st Assembly.

They will also exchange views from a youth perspective on the draft resolution under consideration at the 141st Assembly entitled *Achieving Universal Health Coverage by 2030: The role of parliaments in ensuring the right to health*.
4. **Update and discussion on the Forum's work plan and activities (2019-2020)**

The Forum will discuss what the IPU has done since April 2019 to support youth participation and consider planned activities.
5. **Preparations for the 142nd Assembly (April 2020)**

The Forum will prepare for the 142nd Assembly by discussing the items on the agenda of the IPU Standing Committees: *Parliamentary strategies to strengthen peace and security against threats and conflicts resulting from climate-related disasters and their consequences*, to be considered by the Standing Committee on Peace and International Security; and *Mainstreaming digitalization and the circular economy to achieve the SDGs, responsible consumption and production*, to be considered by the Standing Committee on Sustainable Development, Finance and Trade.

In accordance with its Rule 6.1, the Forum will appoint rapporteurs to prepare youth overview reports on the above-mentioned subject items.



6. Q & A on youth policies

The World Future Council organizes an award every year to celebrate exemplary policies for future generations. This year, the theme of the award is on youth empowerment. The award will highlight proven policies that effectively promote and scale up local, national and international youth empowerment solutions. The IPU, along with the World Future Council, the United Nations and other organizations, are working together to identify and honour exemplary youth policies. Winners will be announced during the 141st IPU Assembly.

The Forum will discuss good practices in youth policy-making. The discussion will also serve to gather the views of young parliamentarians on what parliaments can do to promote policies and pass laws that advance the empowerment of youth, foster youth entrepreneurship and enable much more civic engagement and political participation of youth.
