During the years of war, the total numbers didn't exceed one million for school students and hardly ten or fifteen thousand university students. Whereas, fortunately, with the emergence of interim, transitional, elect and then National Unity Government and with the consolidated efforts by government and parliament of Afghanistan, the number of school enrollments is well above ten million and university students above one hundred and sixty thousand students now. Afghanistan parliament has constantly taken significant strides to ensure proper education through oversight and approval of comprehensive laws. It is unfortunate that there still are areas at war in Afghanistan where rule of law is challenged. Sadly, education opportunities don't exist there.
