That is why, a few days ago, leading parliamentarians from all political parties represented in the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, launched an initiative that should lead to a solution to the political crisis and initiate the work of legislative and executive power in the country.

This example is just one of many that demonstrate significant and important role of parliamentarians, democratically elected representatives of peoples and citizens, in resolving conflicts and political crisis. We really need to be and we really are promotors of political dialogue, the establishment of meaningful interstate relations and cooperation, both in the Western Balkan region and the whole world.
