The 141<sup>st</sup> IPU Assembly appointed as co-Rapporteurs:

It further decided that a male parliamentarian from Thailand should become the third co-Rapporteur. That appointment should be confirmed at the 142<sup>nd</sup> IPU Assembly.
  - (b) Preparatory debate on the next resolution

The preparatory debate provides an opportunity for all Members to express their opinion on the issues to be included in the resolution. In addition, Members can submit written input to the resolution up to 11 May 2020.

Members' contributions will assist the co-Rapporteurs in drafting the resolution, which will be examined at the 143<sup>rd</sup> IPU Assembly in October 2020.
4. **Debate on *The influence of the Internet on democracy***

Within this debate, which follows on from the 2015 resolution on privacy in the digital era, there will be a focus on challenges relating to elections, disinformation and hate speech.
5. **Elections to the Bureau of the Standing Committee**

The Committee will fill the vacancies on the Bureau based on proposals received from the geopolitical groups. The Committee will also elect a new President and Vice-President from among the Bureau members.
