in October 2021.

All other statutory bodies will remain in their current configuration until the next Assembly (March 2021), when elections will be held.

In accordance with Article 25.6 of the Statutes, if a member of the Executive Committee ceases to be a parliamentarian, the IPU Member concerned shall appoint a substitute to serve until the next session of the Governing Council, when an election shall be held. If the newly elected member is from a different parliament than the outgoing member, s/he will serve a full term. Otherwise, the new member shall complete the term of office of his/her predecessor.
