## Amendments to the IPU Statutes and Rules

COMMUNICATION ADDRESSED TO THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION FOR MEMBER PARLIAMENTS AND EXTERNAL RELATIONS OF THE IPU BY THE CHAIR OF THE SWEDISH PARLIAMENT'S IPU DELEGATION

Dear Madam Director,

Many thanks for your letter from 26 January on the proposed revisions to the IPU Statutes and Rules, which have been prepared by the IPU Secretariat.

The Swedish IPU delegation has conducted a detailed review of the proposed amendments and concludes that the consequences of the suggested amendments are so far reaching that it strongly objects to the procedure outlined in the letter. A procedure whereby member states are now required to submit any sub-amendments directly to the Governing Council and the Assembly. The suggested timeframe for review is insufficient and in addition, any revisions of the IPU Statutes and Rules should involve in depth consultation of both the Executive Committee and the Geopolitical groups. Finally, our careful review of the suggested revisions has led to many questions, which we feel would require answers in order for us to be able to provide our final assessment of the suggested amendments.

Hence, Sweden calls for the Executive Committee to come up with a realistic schedule for this process, which should also allow for IPU's Geopolitical Groups and its Member States to conduct a thorough review of all suggested amendments and their impact on the organisation.
